FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: Last year we were unable to continue with the First Holy Communion program, which had not long been started when the lockdown happened. This means we are a year behind, and those children are a year older. We are going to have three special Masses on Sundays in May for those children who were preparing last year to make their First Holy Communion with their families. These will be as follows:

St Joseph's Sunday 23rd May at 12 Noon.

NEW COLLECTION BOXES: The new boxes with envelopes for the Sunday collection are now available at the back of church. PRAYING THE ROSARY FOR THE END OF THE PANDEMIC: The Rosary promoted by Pope Francis will begin at 12.30 pm on 1st May "to invoke the end of the pandemic". The pontiff himself will start the prayer marathon from the Gregorian chapel in the Vatican basilica, along with some 30 shrines around the world, including our own national shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham. Holy See media will broadcast the prayer live at 6 pm every day, with a final one by Francis on 31 May. Undertaken by the Pontifical Council for the New Evangelisation, the initiative is centred on the theme "The whole Church was fervently praying to God" (Acts 12:5) and is addressed to every shrine, that they may encourage the faithful, families and communities to recite the Rosary for "the various categories of people most affected by the plight of the pandemic: for those who have not been able to say goodbye to their loved ones, for all health care personnel, for the poor, the homeless and those in economic difficulty and for all the deceased."

YOUTH STATIONS OF THE CROSS have been taken down for this year. They will now be hung in the Hall. Thank you to: everyone who hosted a Station; all the artists and everyone who walked and prayed.

CAFOD NEWS: Thank you for your generous donations to CAFOD's Family Fast Day during Lent. We featured Marian and her son Svondo in Zimbabwe in Lent 2018.
