Message from Fr. Peter: This **Tuesday at SJ's at 11:30am** it will be our privilege to celebrate the Requiem of Fr. Harry Holden led by the Bishop, followed by a committal at the Crematorium, at which I will have the privilege of presiding. Although there is no official Deanery Mass or Reception service, there will also be a **Mass at SJs at 7pm on Monday night for the repose of Fr. Harry's soul**. Fr. Harry was born in Lytham Saint Anne's on 13th April 1935 to parents Harry and Madge. He attended St Gregory's R.C. School in Preston before going to St Joseph's College, Upholland where he completed his seminary years, being ordained on 27th May 1961 in Preston. After serving in many parishes around the Diocese and also a stint as secretary to Bishop Pearson, Fr. Harry's family. May he rest in peace. *Lord God, you chose our brother Harry to serve your people as a priest and to share the joys and burdens of our lives. Look with mercy on him and give him the reward of his labours, the fullness of live promised to those who preach your holy Gospel. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.*
