This Sunday's Readings As we come to the end of the Church's year we are called to rejoice in our one Lord, Jesus Christ, who calls us all to freedom and forgiveness of our sins.

First Reading 2 Samuel 5:1-3 All the tribes of Israel choose David as their king.

Second Reading *Colossians 1:12-20* The Son holds all things in unity and reconciles everything in heaven and everything on earth.

Gospel Luke 23:35-43 Jesus promises the gift of the kingdom to the criminal who believes in him.

Message from Father Peter: We are blessed at SJSP's to have beautiful music at our weekend services, and other services throughout the work too (especial thanks to all our singers and musicians), which enable us to sing many and varied hymns from the vast and great (and sometimes not-so-great) Hymnology of the Church. Surely one of our greatest and joyful hymns is the Anthem of today's Feast, 'Hail Redeemer King Divine'. As you know the Sundays of the Year run on a three year cycle and the verses of this hymn make reference to this, speaking of the Kingship of Christ in its different ways: in Year A we think of the whole of Creation bowing before the King at the Last Judgement; Year B focuses on the King whose Kingdom is not of this world; whilst Year C, of which this is the last Sunday, sees the Kingdom, Paradise, being offered to even the most unlikely, who put their trust in him. The Hymn also speaks of the Kingdom of Christ as a Shepherd guides his flock, and even makes reference to Him guiding the Youth, a salutary reminder to us all about the future of the Church – and also that this is 'Youth Sunday' in England and Wales. There are so many facets to this final Sunday of the Church's Year, just as there are of the title 'Christ the King'. However we wish to celebrate this Feast lets make sure that we echo in our prayers and in our lives the chorus of this great hymn, and make it a fitting end to our Liturgical Year, as we look forward to beginning another Year with the First Sunday of Advent next week and make our preparations for the celebration of the birth of this King: 'Angels, Saints and Nations sing: 'Praise be Jesus Christ our King; Lord of life, earth, sky and sea, King of love on Calvary!'
